Suzannah Morrison is a Sustainability Leader with a background in the creative industry: film/television, arts management. Morrison delivers results within large scale time critical projects, this has seen her professionally recognised multiple times.

Morrison now shares her expertise in sustainability for complex sites with the film/television industry.

Her interest and action in sustainability was ignited in 2012, when Morrison pivoted to create an award-winning boutique cleaning service, *Swept Away*. Swept Away specialised in chemical-free cleaning using high-pressure, high-temperature steam/vapour.

From 2018 Morrison began sustainable facilities management on major infrastructure project sites in Melbourne, Australia as a leader of behavioural change. Morrison manages data capture and reporting for Energy, Waste and Water in a format easily available for external audits, utilising a range of reporting platforms. This passion and experience was recognised in 2023 when she was awarded the VWMA Award for Female Leadership in Waste Management and Recycling.

With a reputation for leadership in waste diversion, Morrison was headhunted by the M80RR Project to join the Sustainability Team for the \$3.6 billion North East Link project in Melbourne's north. Her reputation for delivering results, implementing initiatives to avoid waste, and promoting positive behavioural change preceded her.

Her presence on the project has seen all of her initiatives adopted to date. Including diverting waste from landfill utilising IOT Method Recycling bins in lunchrooms to capture real-time data.
